SURGICAL PROCEDURE TO BE PERFORMED

All surgery involves some risk because the patient must undergo an anesthetic episode. While this hospital's doctors and staff endorse and conform to the standards prescribed by the American Animal Hospital Association to minimize these risks, additional procedures, listed below, will assist us in identifying potential problems before they occur and will help us design and implement the safest anesthetic protocol. **The following procedures are advised based on the age and physical state of your pet.**

Patients less than 4 years we recommend Blood screen 5 \$38.00 CBC-Complete Blood Count \$28.00

Patients 4 to 6 years we recommend Blood Screen 12 \$55.00 CBC-Complete Blood Count \$28.00

Patients 7 and over are required to have bloodwork and fluid therapy with all anesthesia

The fees are: Blood Screen 12 \$55.00 CBC-Complete Blood Count \$28.00 Fluid Therapy \$50.00

If your pet is having a growth/tumor removed today:

We recommend that growths/ tumors be sent to a laboratory for a pathologist to analyze the cells and make a determination on the type of growth/ tumor that has been removed from your pet. (called histopathology)

Surgery performed on patients that are obese, pregnant, in heat or have retained testicles is more difficult. Therefore, there is an additional charge for these procedures.

Modern anesthetics are effective in providing pain-free surgery; however they wear off quickly. Some pets may experience mild to moderate discomfort post surgery. The doctors at Animal Medical & Surgical Center know recovery is easier if pain can be managed. To comfort your pet, an injection for pain will be given at the hospital and pain medication will be sent home. The fee is \$27.00.

As the owner or the agent for the owner, I give my consent to the Animal Medical & Surgical Center to perform surgery on the above named animal. The nature of the procedure and the risks involved have been explained to me and I understand them fully. I agree to pay for the services at the time they are rendered.
